Abstract: The aim of the thesis is to highlight the importance of the dimensions of sustainability and the development of dynamic simulation models to improve energy efficiency in the power sector, in line with the requirement of sustainability towards sustainable development at global scale. The initial bibliographic research aims at outlining, classifying and evaluating the basic parameters taken into account in the development and management of an electricity system based on their environmental, economic, social and strategic performance. At a second stage, the development of a transition system model from conventional forms of energy to renewable sources is attempted through various adoption policies, according to the methodological approach of Dynamic Systems. One of the examples of the three(3) simulation models implemented along the doctoral thesis is achieved by modeling, simulating and evaluating the business operation and promoting the services and solutions offered by the Energy Services Companies in terms of the impact of various promotional practices on the overall rate of adoption of green energy to replace conventional generating energy in a certain market. The monitoring and evaluation of a typical example of energy-saving program follows that emphasize not only at the improvement of energy efficiency in the residential housing sector at national level, but also at the calibration of the simulation models and insights provided regarding real data. Last but not least, significant conclusions are extracted regarding the adoption of specific policy decisions on the performance and sustainability of an electricity system and the current trends and prospects that should be taken into account in the development of efficient, sustainable policies.
